- Linkage: To identify Pending FDID Errors.

CAT Transaction Technical Specification Updates

IM Technical Specification Publication and Updates

- v4.1.0 r8 of the Phase 2d Industry Member CAT Reporting Technical Specifications (clean and redlined) were updated and published on May 30, 2025.
- Updates include:
 - Updated Section 2.4.2.1 FDID Validation to include additional scope regarding *firmDesignatedID* value of 'PENDING'.
 - Clarified *firmDesignatedID* of 'PENDING' language throughout document to note that corrections can be used in addition to supplement events.
 - Updated descriptions to *aggregatedOrders* and *firmDesignatedID* fields on MENOS and MONOS events.
 - Updated descriptions to *aggregatedOrders, firmDesignatedID and routeRejectedFlag* fields on MLOS event.
 - Updated descriptions to *firmDesignatedID* and *quoteRejectedFlag* fields on MLQS event.
 - Added Error Code 2269 related to *firmDesignatedID* and *aggregatedOrders* fields on supplement events.
 - Added Error Code 2270 related to *firmDesignatedID* field on supplement events.
 - Added Error Code 2271 regarding *firmDesignatedID*, *aggregatedOrders* and *routeRejectedFlag* fields on supplement events.
 - Added Error Code 2272 regarding *firmDesignatedID* and *quoteRejectedFlag* on supplement events.
 - Updated Table 157: Steps in Linkage Discovery regarding FDID Validation including firmDesignatedID value of 'PENDING'
 - Added Error Code 3711 related to *firmDesignatedID of* 'PENDING' on new orders.
 - Updated description of Error Code 2088.
 - Retired Error Code 2137.
 - Added clarifying language to Section 5.2 Multi Leg/Complex Option Order Events and Appendix G: Data Dictionary regarding the *handlingInstructions* value 'CMPX'
 - Incorporated minor typographical and formatting errors throughout the document.

firmDesignatedID with a value of 'PENDING'

- The Transaction Technical Specifications allow Industry Members to populate the *firmDesignatedID* with a value of 'PENDING' when a new order is received, and the new account number is not yet available.
 - Once the FDID becomes available, the Industry Member must report the actual FDID in the *firmDesignatedID* field in an Order Supplement. Any Supplement event with an FDID populated will not be considered late for CAT reporting purposes if it is received by T+3 @ 8:00 AM ET.
 - Alternatively, Industry Members can correct the FDID value on the new order event within T+3 @ 8:00 AM ET.

Updates to Section 2.4.2.1 FDID Validation

- Traditionally, FDID Validations (3700 series errors) have looked at Transaction reporting and referenced CAIS reporting.
- The new validations and feedback delivery for the 'PENDING' FDID errors will generate interfirm linkage errors that are also summarized in a separate summary file. These errors are not rejections; the events still participate in linkage.
- Updated FDID Validation Language:
 - Effective on September 29, 2025, CAT will also generate FDID validation errors when the *firmDesignatedID* field is populated with a value of 'PENDING' in instances when an Industry Member receives an order for a new account and the new account number, on which the FDID is based, is not yet available for creation and reporting the CAT new order event. *FDID validation errors related to the use of the 'PENDING' value in the firmDesignatedID field must be corrected within T+3 @ 8:00 AM ET by either reporting the actual FDID value in a New Order Supplement event or by a correction to the original submission using actionType 'COR'.*

Conforming FDID Validation Updates

- FDID validation errors related to the use of the 'PENDING' value in the firmDesignatedID field must be corrected within T+3 @ 8:00 AM ET by either reporting the actual FDID value in a New Order Supplement event or by submitting a correction to the original submission using actionType 'COR'.
- Updated Table 157: Steps in Linkage Discovery to include PENDING validation as part of the FDID Validation process.

Additional Validations

- Order Supplements can be used for different purposes, depending on the event, including to update an FDID value reported on the New Order Event, to add additional aggregated orders to a New Order, and to update the status of the *routeRejectedFlag or quoteRejectedFlag*.
 - Validations were added to ensure that the supplement events are used for their intended use.
- Added clarifying language to aggregatedOrders and firmDesignatedID fields on MENOS and MONOS events.
- Updated descriptions to *firmDesignatedID* and *quoteRejectedFlag* fields on MLQS event.
- Updated descriptions to aggregatedOrders, firmDesignatedID and routeRejectedFlag fields on MLOS event.

3711 Errors and Statistics, Compliance Rate and Report Cards

- 'PENDING' FDID Errors will be included in overall compliance rate and report cards in a phased approach
- Phase 1 (September 2025)
 - 1. Identify, generate new error code and provide in existing feedback files, reconcile FDID updates
 - 2. Display in daily reporting summary (Not included in Compliance Rate)
- Phase 2 (Future Date TBD)
 - 1. Include in Compliance Rate in daily reporting summary
 - 2. Add to report card beginning of a quarter

Additional Updates

- Updated Error Code 2088 to include Missing or Invalid routeRejectedFlag
- Retired Error Code 2137 Invalid correction, deletion or a repair and updated language in Section 7.6.2 Firm Initiated Corrections
 - Firm initiated correction records must assign the firmROEID equal to the firmROEID of the original submission., otherwise the record will be rejected.
- Incorporated minor typographical and formatting errors throughout the document.

'CMPX' handlingInstructions value

- Added clarifying language to Section 5.2 Multi Leg/Complex Option Order Events
- Updated Appendix G: Data Dictionary regarding the *handlingInstructions* value 'CMPX'.
 - Electronic message representing an individual simple option or equity leg of a complex option order that was optionally reported to CAT. This event represents an electronic message for a partial component of multi-leg event that was manually reported. Applicable to simple option orders, equity leg orders and multi-leg orders. See Section 5.2 for additional information.

CAT Transaction Reporting Scenario Updates

Reporting Scenarios Publication and Updates

- Industry Member Reporting Scenarios v4.15 (clean and redlined) were updated and published on May 30, 2025.
- Updates include:
 - Added Section 8.7 covering SPHR Floor Broker scenarios.
 - Added clarifying language to Scenario 3.6.3 covering the use of *handlingInstructions* value of 'CMPX' to be applicable to multi-leg events.
 - Updated Scenario 5.1.1 to reflect the option to report the actual FDID value by submitting a correction to the original submission using *actionType 'COR'*.
 - Minor typographical correction in the document.

Added SPHR Floor Broker Scenarios

- SPHR Options Floor Broker Receives Offsetting Orders for Crossing in Open Outcry (no market interference)
- SPHR Options Floor Broker Receives Offsetting Orders for Crossing in Open Outcry (Floor Market Maker takes partial contra side)
- SPHR Options Floor Broker Receives Offsetting Multi-leg Orders for Crossing in Open Outcry (Floor Market Maker takes full contra side).

Additional Updates

- Added clarifying language to Scenario 3.6.3 covering the use of *handlingInstructions* value 'CMPX' to be applicable for multi-leg events.
- Updated Scenario 5.1.1 to reflect the option to report the actual FDID value by submitting a correction the original submission using *actionType 'COR'*.
 - Once the account number is established on T+1, the Industry Member must report a New Order Supplement event or by submitting a correction to the original submission using *actionType* 'COR' with the FDID of the newly established account. FDID validation errors related to the use of the 'PENDING' value in the *firmDesignatedID* field must be corrected within T+3 @ 8:00 AM ET.
- Minor typographical correction in the document.
